We are excited that you are interested in becoming a part of the Fort Collins High School Cheerleading Team! Please read through all of the following information carefully before arriving on April, 20, 2026 for the first day of tryouts. In this packet, you will find information on information for tryouts, tryout procedures and general information on being an FCHS Cheerleader.

Our FCHS cheer team consists of a Varsity and Junior Varsity cheer team. We encourage all ability levels to try out. Prior to tryouts, you must have all of the following completed or you will not be allowed to participate.

 - *You must bring the Orange Card with you to the first day of tryouts in order to participate*

Being an FCHS Cheerleader

Anyone can be a FCHS Cheerleader! We do not require any prior cheer experience for tryouts. Students who are a freshman, sophomore, junior, or senior at Fort Collins High School are welcome to try out for our Cheer team. There will be no specific number of students from each grade level selected.

Cheerleading at FCHS is both a job and a privilege. If you are selected, you will be expected to hold yourself to the highest standard of behavior and performance. Being a FCHS Cheerleader is a year-long commitment. Cheerleading is a team sport and requires that every team member be present to be successful.

There is the possibility that you can still participate in another sport, these instances will be handled on a case by case basis. By trying out you are agreeing to make FCHS cheer your priority and as such make the time commitment required to be a successful and contributing member of the FCHS Cheerleading team.

The time commitment for cheer depends on whether you are on the Varsity or JV Team. The JV team has practices twice a week with 1-2 additional cheer events each week. The Varsity team has practices twice a week with 2-3 additional cheer events each week. Varsity is also required to participate in competitions and competition practices can add another 1-2 practices each week.

Financial Obligations

Along with a time commitment, all members of the team will have a financial commitment as well. All team members will be responsible to cover costs for their own uniforms, warm-ups, shoes, backpack, poms, practice clothes, etc. Members of the Varsity team will also be responsible for the additional fees for competition choreography, competition warm-ups, and other competition costs. The FCHS Cheer team will participate in fundraisers throughout the year to off-set these costs as well.

The Estimated Costs for the Season are as follows:

Varsity \approx \$2,500 - \$3,000

Junior Varsity \approx \$1,500 - \$2,000

For Varsity, the estimated cost of the season does not include the cost for competitions. The costs will also differ based on whether you are returning to the FCHS cheer program/team or are brand new.

The costs are not expected to be paid all up front in one lump sum but are rather spread out over the first several months of the season.

Tryout Procedures

When you arrive at the first day of tryouts, you must turn in pages 4-6 of this packet along with an Orange Card. You will only be allowed to participate at tryouts if you have completed the Student Tryout Information Sheet, filled out Student Questionnaire, signed the Contract page, and have an Orange Card on the first day of Tryouts.

To obtain an Orange Card, you will need to get a physical done by your doctor as well as complete and turn in pages 8-12 to the Athletic Secretary at Fort Collins High School. A district athletic participation fee will also be required to get an Orange Card. This fee can be paid online on School Pay or in-person to the FCHS bookkeeper. Free/Reduced Lunch Waivers are also available for qualifying students.

At the tryout practices, all participants will learn a Cheer, Chant, and Dance, as well as cheer motions, jumps and stunting.

Dress for Tryouts

Please come to tryouts prepared and ready to work. Please make sure that you are wearing FCHS colors (purple, gold/yellow, white) to promote your school spirit. Wear your hair up and out of your face and no jewelry and nails longer than your fingertips are allowed. If you do not adhere to these requirements, you will be asked to sit out.

Team Selection

Following the final day of tryouts on August 28th, the results will be posted at the school on Saturday. Once the team has been selected, further information on being a FCHS Cheerleader will be given at the New Team Athlete and Parent Meeting, including more information in detail on expenses, important dates, practice schedules, and team rules, regulations and expectations. The meeting is mandatory for all athletes and parents!
